

Memorial to Mandy Koenigsberg

Amanda (Mandy) Michele Koenigsberg. March 13,1971-August 9,2020. Mandy was first initiated into the Daughters of Union Veterans of the Civil War 1861-1865, Ruth F. Barnhart Tent 56,



Pleasant Unity, PA on March 25, 2014 at a regular tent meeting located at the Hoss' Steak and Sea in Greensburg, PA. Her qualifying ancestor is Pvt. Harlow Sherwood of Company H, 24th Michigan Infantry. Due to distance of Tent 54 being far from home, Mandy decided to gather a group of ladies and together they formed the Clara Barton Tent 64, Ebensburg, PA. At a ceremony held on November 19, 2016, after the Remembrance Day parade in Gettysburg, the Clara Barton Tent #64 was initiated and installed. Mandy was installed as the Tent President, a position she held for 4 years until her passing. Once the new tent was official Mandy became a comrade member of Ruth F. Barnhart Tent 54, and Susanna Cook Tent #61, of Somerset, PA. Mandy was a big advocate for the veterans of Cambria County. The project that she loved the most was the Wreaths Across America project that her tent has undertaken for the past 4 years. Mandy was also a lineal member of Mary Campbell Camp 16, ASUVCW in Johnstown where she served

as the camp Patriotic Instructor, and a member of Comrade Gabrio Corps 136 of the Women's Relief Corps, where she held the office of Junior Vice President. Mandy was laid to rest on August 19, 2020 at the Saint Michael the Archangel Cemetery in Loretto, PA, where a DUVCW and WRC memorial service will be held on October 11, 2020. **All members of the Allied orders are invited.
